Deposits - To secure a student's enrollment, a **non-refundable deposit of \$25 and a registration fee of \$5 for each camp** must be included with each registration form. The deposit will be applied to the total cost of the camp.

Extended Care Before and After-care are the perfect solution for busy families whose work schedules do not allow for drop-off and pick-up when a camp begins or ends. Before care is offered from 7:30-9:00 am; after-care is offered from 3:30-5:30 pm. The cost is \$6/hour, which is billed in 15 minute increments. After-care ends promptly at 5:30 pm. A \$5/minute late charge will be assessed beginning at 5:30 pm. A 5% service charge is added through ACTIVE

Check-in - Registration takes place every Monday morning in the main foyer at the south entrance of the Topeka Collegiate School Campus. All campers must check-in at the beginning of each week of camp. Please walk younger students into the building.

Behavior Policy

Appropriate discipline enhances the safety and enjoyment of the children. Every student attending Summer Adventures must follow school procedures and standards of behavior. Consideration of others in thought and action is expected. Summer Adventures reserves the right to require the withdrawal of any student who poses a discipline problem or a disruption to the learning experience. No refunds will be issued for students who are asked to withdraw.

Cancellations - TCS reserves the right to cancel a class at any time due to low enrollment. You will be notified in advance and given the option of transferring class fees towards another class or receiving a full refund for the class cancelled (minus the \$5 registration fee.)

Parents wishing to cancel or transfer their child's registration from a class may do so seven days prior to the first day of class. Class fees will be refunded in the manner that they were paid, minus the deposit of \$25. Cancellations received after this deadline will not be eligible for any refund. Please understand that we have made firm financial commitments to our faculty and staff in addition to purchasing materials. If you discover your child(ren) are unable to attend any of the class(es) for which they are registered, you may transfer them to a different class. Please make that request through Katrina Van Aalst, Summer Adventures Director, to avoid any additional registration fees.

Lunch and Snacks - Campers should bring a sack lunch labeled with their name and a drink if they will be staying over lunch. We do not have vending machines on campus. All half-day campers are encouraged to bring a snack and water bottle to camp each day.

Special Notes - Please make the Summer Adventures Director aware of any specific problems or circumstances that might affect your child's summer experience. Please also provide the Summer Adventures Director or Assistant Director with a list of individuals approved to pick up your child, as well as their contact information. NO camps will be held the week of July 4.
