How it works: Raise awareness of conservation issues by writing a <u>fictional story</u> about real-life problems happening to plants and animals around the world. You could write about habitat loss, poaching, pollution, the illegal pet trade, and more. Age categories: Kindergarten-2nd grade; 3rd-5th grade; 6th-8th grade; 9th-12th grade; Adult —> one winner per age category

Submission deadline: April 14th, 2019

Prizes: Each winner will choose either a behind-the-scenes animal tour or a painting done by a zoo animal.
