National History Day

National Merit Scholars

- Alums make up less than 2% of Shawnee County high school seniors but represent, on average, 25% of the National Merit Scholar Semi-Finalists
- In 2019, alums made up 57% of Shawnee County National Merit Semi-Finalists

Foundational Education

- 605 Graduates and served 1,820 students in first 40 years
- Educating children from 14 different zip codes
- 90% of the Class of 2019 are in the Top 10% of their senior class
- First and only Independent non-parochial school in county

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

- 501 (c)(3) since 1982
- Has not borrowed from a financial institution for over 20 years
- Endowment Funds totals \$1.4 million
- Receives no governmental or religious funding
- 85% of revenue comes from Tuition, Fees, Programming, and Fundraising
- 83% of expenses go to Salaries, Benefits, and Instructional costs
