All middle school students will be provided with service to the local community during the school day four times a year. These hours may be counted. In addition, we encourage students to initiate their own personal community service involvement. Although any such involvement is voluntary, we would like to acknowledge those who do volunteer. Students with:

- * 5-49 hours of volunteer service will be recognized with a Service Award,
- * 50-100 hours of volunteer service hours will receive a Service Learning Silver Award,
- * over 100 hours of volunteer service hours will receive a Service Learning Gold Award.

All three categories of service awards will be presented at the Middle School Recognition Assembly on May 14, 2025. **Please complete this form and return it to the office by Tuesday, April 15, 2025.** The eligible hours for service are between June 1, 2024, and April 14, 2025. Volunteer hours are defined as unpaid service, outside of the student's family, that benefits a person, organization, church, or community. Service cannot be counted if it was performed in exchange for payment or any form of benefit.
