In an effort to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, students who attend after-care or adventures will need to bring a third mask for the day. We are also asking families not to enter the building during pick-up and drop-off this year. All students attending before-care should enter the main entrance doors regardless of their designated door. Please walk your student to the door or watch them enter the building from your vehicle before leaving.

For after-care, we are excited to announce a courtyard circle drive pick-up line this year! Any parent who does not pick up their student at the designated dismissal time will pick up their student in the courtyard circle drive. To allow middle school students to safely cross the courtyard at dismissal, the circle drive will not open until 3:50 PM. If parents arrive after dismissal but before 3:50 PM, they will need to wait on Hope Street until the gate is unlocked. Families will drive around to the fence on the south side and wait by the windows to the extended day room. They should send a message to the **Google Voice number 785-422-7382** (4CareTC) to let the extended care staff know they are there to pick up their student. Extended care staff members will look through the windows and verify that the person in the car is on the student's authorized pick-up list. If the staff does not recognize the person, they will walk the student out to the car and ask the person for an ID.

Students attending adventures will be escorted to the main entrance. If their parents are not waiting outside, they will check into after-care and be picked up in the circle drive.
