- $\ \square$ Discuss screen time preferences versus completing independent work packets.
- ☐ Review the daily/weekly schedule with the family. Discuss where to find updates.
- ☐ Confirm that everyone is ready to receive livestreaming:
 - Discuss sending/accepting calendar invites
 - Teachers will use the 'repeat' setting when appropriate
 - Teachers will send calendar invites via student email address
 - Student emails/passwords will be available during Meet the Teacher/Classroom Visits
