

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Summer Blast? How is it different than Topeka Collegiate's Summer Adventures programming in the past?

For over twenty years, Topeka Collegiate has hosted a safe and popular summer program called "Summer Adventures." This year, we have revamped this program to meet the needs of today's families. Summer Blast provides a full-day summer camp solution that is less about the exact topic of focus but more about safe, dependable fun that is built for children. Each week's theme will be designed with kids in mind and include games, arts, crafts, music, free play time, creativity, exploration, and physical activity.

What are the hours of Summer Blast?

Blast time is 9:00 AM-3:30 PM Monday-Friday. For an added convenience and \$25 fee per week fee, parents may take advantage of beforecare, starting at 7:30 AM, or aftercare, ending at 5:00 PM.

When is the first week of camp?

The first week of camp is June 6, 2022. You may choose to enroll week-by-week, or for the entire summer. Summer Blast will last for seven weeks concluding on Friday, July 29. There is no offering July 4-8.

Does my child have to attend Topeka Collegiate to join Summer Blast?

No, your child does not have to attend Topeka Collegiate to enroll in Summer Blast, however Topeka Collegiate students will be able to have an early registration option on March 1 and 2. Summer Blast welcomes students from across the region.

What are the age limits of Summer Blast?

Camps are designed for children who have completed kindergarten; serving first through eighth grade students.

How much will it cost?

The Summer Blast fee is \$200 per week. Summer Blast with extended care is \$225 per week. Current Collegiate families will receive a 10% discount. All families will see a 10% discount when they register for four or more camps.

Will lunch be provided during camp?

Campers should bring a sack lunch and water bottle each day. On Wednesdays, they may bring a sack lunch or participate in a special pizza party lunch (Wednesdays only)! Campers may also bring snacks, if needed.

How much do I pay at registration?

Each week's registration requires a non-refundable deposit of \$100 plus a \$5 registration fee. The remaining balance is charged on the first day of Blast camp.

Will students be required to wear masks:

Decisions regarding face coverings will be made one week prior to each camp. Masks will be recommended if not required.
