## TOPEKA COLLEGIATE ADVENTURES PROGRAM INFORMATION

Fall Adventures will start the week of August 23. The deadline for enrollment is August 20.

SCHEDULE: Lower school students will check into after-care at 3:35 PM. Middle school students will check in at 3:45 PM. They will be provided a snack before their Adventure starts at 4:00 PM. All Adventures end at 5:00 PM except for choir which ends at 5:15 PM.

ENROLLMENT: Adventures are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Families will enroll on Active.com. The link for each semester will be in the Collegiate Connection and on the school website. To secure your child's spot in a Fall Adventure, enroll online by August 20. Only students who are enrolled in the adventure are allowed to attend the adventure.

CANCELLED CLASSES: Topeka Collegiate reserves the right to cancel an Adventure due to low enrollment. You will be notified in advance and given the option of transferring enrollment fees towards another class or receiving a refund for the class cancelled (minus the processing fee).

COST/PAYMENT INFORMATION: Each adventure costs \$140 for the semester except for choir which costs \$210. Families pay on Active.com when they enroll. Active.com charges a 5% processing fee for each Adventure. Students are enrolled by semester. Non-refundable payment is collected at time of registration. If a family chooses to withdraw a student from an adventure after the enrollment deadline, no refunds will be given.

PICK-UP: Authorized pick-up individuals will enter the main doors. Adventure instructors will escort the students to the main entrance concluding the Adventure. Students who do not have a parent/guardian waiting for them will be signed into after-care. The rate for after-care is \$6.00 per hour and is billed by the minute. After-care ends at 5:25 PM. If students are not picked up by 5:25 PM, families will be charged late fees. If students are not picked up by 5:30 PM, they will be escorted to TAT class and enrolled for the semester. The \$300 charge for TAT will be added to the family's FACTS account. Rates will not be prorated if this occurs in the middle or end of the semester.

COMMUNICATION: If you need to contact the after-care providers or your student after the office is closed, call 785-228-0490 ext. 2112. Care providers cannot always answer the phone and will not be able to access the voicemail, so please email the director if there is no an answer at the After-care extension. Please let Director Rebecca Bonilla (rbonilla@topekacollegiate.org) know of any concerns or special circumstances that might affect your child's experience.

#### **ADVENTURES OFFERED**

#### Tuesdays

Inspiring Painters (Grades K-8) - Let your creativity soar in this adventure! Each week we will learn a new painting technique and create a masterpiece to take home. Salt painting, puffy paint, and stained glass painting are just a few of the techniques we will use this semester! Be prepared to get a bit messy, and feel free to bring a painting shirt with you.

Something Sweet with Mrs. Smith (Grades 3-8) - Join Mrs. Smith on Wednesday afternoons to make something sweet! Lessons will explore nutrition, baking tools, measurements, and ingredient substitution. By the end of this adventure, students will have a notebook full of new recipes and baking tips that will last a lifetime!

#### Wednesdays

Choir offers students the chance to sing music with multiple voice parts and offers the challenge of solo parts and a chance to audition for State Honor Choir if interested. Members participate in area festivals, when occurring.

Marvel Madness (Grades 2-8) - In this adventure you will watch Marvel movies and the latest cool videos. You will also read comics, learn about the heroes, make tier lists on heroes, and draw characters. Last but not least, you will create our own hero and play superheroes themed games.

Instructor: Teddy Decker. Mr. Teddy is an afterschool care provider, a summer adventures instructor as well as a Topeka Collegiate alum.

#### Thursdays

Chess Club (Grades K-8) - Chess Club is an opportunity to learn the game and improve one's skill. Absolute beginners are welcome and will be taught the basic rules and concepts. More experienced players will learn different openings, strategies, and tactics and will challenge themselves by solving chess puzzles. While students will have the chance to measure their progress through wins and losses against their peers, the main focus will be encouraging good sportsmanship and having fun.

Instructors: Sho Glashausser and assistant Yumiko Glashauser. Mr. Sho is a chess champion and a Topeka Collegiate Alum, and Mrs. Glashausser works in the Topeka Collegiate lunch room.

Games Galore (Grades K-8) - Do you play video games like Minecraft, Mario, and Pokémon? How about card games like Pitch, Kings in a Corner, and Slap Jack? Do you enjoy board games, like Monopoly, Clue, and Telestrations? How about active games like Red Light Green, Red Rover, and Simon Says? If you answered yes to any of these questions, this Adventure is for you! Every week you'll get to choose what fun games you want to play.

Dungeons and Dragons (Grades 4-8) - Join this adventure for fun, weekly activities aimed to improve your experience with the world's greatest roleplaying game: Dungeons and Dragons! Writing characters, building worlds, and creating monsters are just some of the topics we'll be covering, as well as dedicated days for quick, one-shot adventures in small groups.
