## **About our Board of Trustees:**

Topeka Collegiate is a 501(c)(3), governed by a Board of Trustees, and managed by a Head of School. The Board of Trustees is a volunteer group of 15-22 people. The Board has ultimate responsibility for the school. It does so by raising funds, managing budgets, serving as the legally accountable body for Topeka Collegiate, appointing a Head of School and setting general school policy. No Board member receives compensation for their participation. Board members should not involve themselves with the normal daily operation of the school except through the operation of duly appointed committees. The Board does not hear complaints, sit as a court of appeals, or overturn the Head's decisions. They do, however, determine the essential nature of the school, its academic emphasis, style of relations with the public, and the methods of self-evaluation to determine effectiveness.
