

To ensure the safety of our students and faculty, the back gate (Hope Street) will be locked all day. All children should enter the school through the Eveningside Drive doors. The Eagle Foyer will be locked at 8:15 AM and remain locked until 3:15 PM. Students and employees have been instructed not to admit visitors through the Eagle Foyer during this period. Please use the main entrance between 8:15 AM and 3:15 PM and sign-in.

We encourage all parents to walk children in and out of the school daily using the Eveningside Drive entrances.

Please do not allow your unaccompanied child to cross Eveningside Drive while exiting or entering your vehicle.

There is a morning drop-off lane for parents of older students, marked by orange cones outside the Eagle Foyer entrance. Please pull forward to the end of the cones and follow the instructions of the faculty member on duty. If you must access your trunk, please pull into a parking spot to prevent inhibiting the other cars in the drop-off lane. There is no parking in this area.



There is no sitting or parking allowed at any time in the crosswalk in front of the school or within the sidewalk entry to the school (see photo to the left).

Remove all valuables from your car and lock the doors while inside the school. Never leave an unaccompanied child in your vehicle.

Keep in mind that the spots marked with blue and white signs are reserved - night and day, year-round. Please refrain from parking in these spots at any time, however briefly. Please do not park in the church/day care parking lot across the street.

Help us be good neighbors: Please note and obey all posted speed limits and one-way streets in the area, including the school zones around the Topeka Collegiate campus.
