



EXAMPLE RATE SCENARIOS

The case study families below were created for illustrative purposes only and are not meant to represent actual Topeka Collegiate families, past or present. These scenarios only reflect basic income situations. Please contact our Director of Admissions, Leilani Grey, to begin the next steps in enrolling at Topeka Collegiate and receiving your unique FIT rate.

Case #1: Josiah's family

(1 student, dual working parents)

Josiah is a 5th grader with two working parents. Their combined income is \$140,000. They completed the FIT evaluation through School and Student Services. Josiah's FIT rate is \$13,377.

Case #2: Tally's family

(1 student, dual working parents)

Tally is a 2nd grader with two working parents. Their combined income is \$124,000. They completed the FIT evaluation through School and Student Services. Tally's FIT rate is \$8,800.

Case #3: John and Joe's family

(Two students, single income household)

John and Joe are 5th grade twins who live in a single income household. The combined income is over \$250,000. They did not choose to complete their FIT evaluation through School and Student Services. John and Joe's FIT rates are \$13,377 and \$13,043.

Case #4: Taki and Rishi's family

(Two students, dual income household)

Taki (K) and Rishi (gr. 4) are children who live in a dual income household. The combined household income is \$174,000. They completed the FIT evaluation through School and Student Services. Taki and Rishi's FIT rates are \$8,000 and \$8,207.

Case #5: Debra's family

(1 student, single income household)

Debra is a student (gr. 1) and only child to a single parent household. Mom has extensive student loan debt and an annual income of \$81,000. They completed the FIT evaluation through School and Student Services and Debra's FIT rate is \$8,200.
