We also encourage students to take part in additional volunteer opportunities on their own. While personal service is optional, we recognize and celebrate students who choose to give their time to others. Students with:

- * 50-100 hours of service hours will receive a Service Learning Silver Award,
- * Over 100 hours of service hours will receive a Service Learning Gold Award.

All three categories of service awards will be presented at the Middle School Recognition Assembly on **May 13, 2026**. Please complete this form and return it to the office by **May 01, 2026**. The eligible hours for service are between **June 1, 2025, and April 30, 2026**. Volunteer hours are defined as unpaid service, outside of the student's family, that benefits a person, organization, church, or community. Service cannot be counted if it was performed in exchange for payment or any form of benefit.
