General Information

Instructors

Instructors in our Summer Adventures program are devoted to making the summer fun and engaging for our participants. Our instructors and teaching assistants have been carefully chosen to provide the highest quality instruction and educational enrichment for students of all ages.

Camp Location

Most summer camps will be held on the Topeka Collegiate campus, 2200 SW Eveningside Drive. However, some camps will be held off campus, so please read this information carefully to ensure that your child will be at the right location.

Deposits

To secure a student's enrollment, a non-refundable deposit of \$25 and a registration fee of \$5 for each camp must be included with each registration form. The deposit will be applied to the total cost of the camp.

Extended Care

Before- and After-care are the perfect solution for busy families whose work schedules do not allow for drop-off and pick-up when a camp begins or ends. Before-care is offered from 7:30 a.m.-9:00 a.m.; After-care is offered from 3:30 p.m.-5:30 p.m. The cost is \$6/hour, which is billed in 15-minute increments. After-care ends promptly at 5:30 p.m. A \$5/minute late charge will be assessed beginning at 5:30 p.m. A 5% service charge is added through ACTIVE.

Attendance

Attendance will be taken each day. Please email Ariel Garrett-Croney (agarrett@topekacollegiate.org) or Ken Park (kpark@topekacollegiate.org) to report an absence or late arrival.

Cancellations

Topeka Collegiate reserves the right to cancel a class at any time due to low enrollment. You will be notified in advance and given the option of transferring enrollment fees towards another class or receiving a full refund for the class canceled (minus the \$5 registration fee).

Parents wishing to cancel or transfer their student's registration from a class may do so seven days prior to the first day of class. Class fees will be refunded in the manner that they were paid, minus the deposit of \$25. Cancellations received after this deadline will not be eligible for any refund. Please understand that we have made firm financial commitments to our faculty and staff in addition to purchasing materials. If you discover your child(ren) are unable to attend any of the class(es) for which they are registered, you may transfer them to a different class. Please make that request through Ariel Garrett-Croney (agarrett@topekacollegiate.org), to avoid any additional registration fees.

Check-In

Registration takes place every Monday morning in the main foyer at the south entrance of the Topeka Collegiate campus. All campers must check-in at the beginning of each week of camp. Please walk younger students into the building.

Behavior Policy

Appropriate discipline enhances the safety of the children. Every student attending Summer Adventures must follow school procedures and standards of behavior. Consideration of others in thought and action is expected. Summer Adventures reserves the right to require the withdrawal of any student who poses a discipline problem or a disruption to the learning experience. No refunds will be issued for students who are asked to withdraw.

Temperature

The school's temperature threshold is 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit. All staff and students will have temperature taken upon arrival and at lunch/recess with a touchless thermometer. Anyone with symptoms of illness, including a temperature above 100.4 degrees, will be sent home immediately. Any person who measures a temperature above will be taken to the Wellness Room (Room 109) until picked-up/departure.

Face Mask Guidance

Masks are required to be worn on campus by all persons over the age of two. Face masks may be disposable or reusable cloth. Families are expected to provide their student's masks. Staff and students will come to camp with a mask on and bring a second mask for application after lunch. Face shields may be used in addition to, but not in place of a face mask.

Hand Washing Hygiene

Hand washing by all staff and students will be done upon arrival to school, before lunch, before recess, and after recess. The afternoon mask should be applied after lunch. Each classroom will be provided hand sanitizer. Hand washing or hand sanitizer should be used when entering and exiting a classroom. Additionally, the school will provide large bottles of sanitizer (with squirt pump) for playgrounds, commons, gym, etc.

Lunch and Snacks

Campers should bring a sack lunch labeled with their name and a drink if they will be staying over lunch. The commons will follow a 50% seated capacity: four persons to each 8-person table. Tables will have quadrant shaped polycarbonate dividers. Once at the table, students may remove their mask. Each lunch group will clean tables with sanitizing spray. All half-day campers are encouraged to bring a snack and water bottle to camp each day. Communal water will not be provided. Bottle-filling stations will be used to refill personal water bottles.

Special Notes

Please make the Summer Adventures Director aware of any specific problems or circumstances that might affect your child's summer experience. Please also provide the Summer Adventures Director or the Assistant Director with a list of individuals approved to pick up your child, as well as their contact information. NO camps will be held the week of July 5 - July 9.
